Dear Parents and Guardians,

We are glad that a member of your family has decided to attend Philippine College of Ministry. At PCM we are doing our best to provide a university style college of the Bible. That means that we believe that the education at PCM is on the same level as the university. It also means that it will be as difficult. Students will need to study diligently regardless of the college they choose. But when students graduate from PCM, they will have a first rate education.

While your son, daughter, or family member is studying at PCM, we will provide three things. First, the full tuition cost of all full time students is covered by scholarship the first year. Full time students who maintain a grade average of "B" or higher may have their scholarships extended through all four years at PCM. We also provide a work-study program that will allow students to earn money to pay for their dormitory expenses. And PCM's Christian Service program allows a student to earn up to 200 pesos monthly serving a church.

But PCM cannot take your place as parents and family. We do not become sponsors or foster parents to our students. YOU will still have a part in the life of your son or daughter in the following ways:

- 1) The PCM scholarship program does not cover food and clothing. You will still have a part in providing these needs.
- 2) There are also fees which are not covered by the scholarship program. Please refer to the WELCOME TO PCM sheet in the Admissions Packet. It will tell how much money students need to bring. Please do not send them without money and please do not assume that the college will pay all of the expenses for your student.
- 3) As parent or guardian, you are still responsible for the conduct of your family member. PCM has rules and regulations that students must obey, but if they disobey these rules repeatedly they will be suspended and sent home. You will be notified if this happens to your family member.
- 4) Please make clear to your son, daughter, or family member *before* they come to PCM what your expectations are concerning proper courting, use of alcohol, tobacco, and illegal drugs, sexual purity, travel, modesty, and obeying the college rules. We believe that if students are responsible to their families, they will have little trouble with discipline at school.

So we ask that you read this letter carefully and indicate with your signature that you have read and understand it. Thank you for your continuing part in the life of your son, daughter, or family member.
